

What to Look for When Referring Your Patients for Egg Freezing

SGF is home to **85,000 babies born**. SGF is one of only a few fertility centers in the U.S. with published pregnancy outcomes for women who return to use their frozen eggs. In SGF patients <34 at the time of freeze, who froze the recommended number of eggs, 70-80% took home a baby, and 50% took home two children.⁴

EXPERTISE



Encourage your patients to ask for outcome data, including what percentage of frozen eggs used were successfully thawed and fertilized. SGF completed 720 egg freezing cycles in 2018, and nearly 500 egg thaw cycles (over 4000 eggs) since 2009. For SGF patients coming back to use their frozen eggs, 70% were successfully thawed and fertilized.

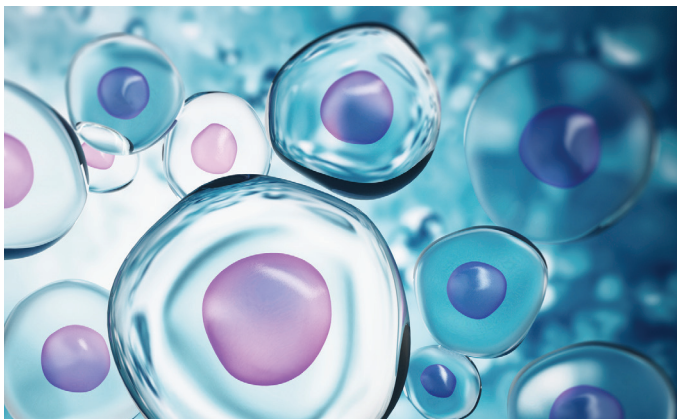

5 Fast Facts about Egg Freezing



- 1 WOMEN ARE WAITING TO CONCEIVE**
20 percent of women today have their first child after age 35.¹
- 2 MOST COMMON REASON WOMEN FREEZE**
Most commonly, women delay childbearing in order to pursue educational, career, or other personal goals.²
- 3 EGG FREEZING AT AN ALL-TIME HIGH**
The number of women freezing their eggs grew 26% from 2016 to 2017.²
- 4 PATIENT AGE AND PHYSICIAN ADVICE MATTERS**
Only 36% of OB/GYNs proactively discuss egg freezing with patients under age 35.³
- 5 TIME IS OF THE ESSENCE**
Best time to look into freezing eggs is early- to mid-30s.⁴
